

**RESOLUTIONS**  
**of the Second**  
**Coordinating Committee Meeting**  
**THE STRUVE GEODETIC ARC**  
**in Haparanda, Sweden, August 14 – 16, 2006**

The delegates of countries of the Struve Geodetic Arc - Norway, Sweden, Finland, Russian Federation, Estonia and Lithuania - present in the Meeting adopted the following resolutions.

**Resolution No. 1**

The Delegates of countries of the Arc

*noting* the *Management Mechanism* for the Struve Geodetic Arc, as agreed in the Moldova Conference in 2004,

*welcome* the national management reports of 2005-2006 presented in this meeting,

*look forward* to continue the management cooperation of the Arc countries for the benefit and success of the Struve Arc as the World Heritage.

**Resolution No. 2**

The Delegates of countries of the Arc

*noting* the early proposals for a logo of the Arc and new proposals made according the fifth Resolution of the Helsinki Meeting in 2005,

*agree* that only the official emblem of World Heritage will be use according the appropriate rules, and no special logo for the Arc will be taken for use.

**Resolution No. 3**

The Delegates of the countries of the Arc

*noting* the idea of the delegation from Lithuania to publish stamps dedicated to the Struve Geodetic Arc as the World Heritage,

*encourage* all the Struve Arc countries to work to get a stamp published in each Struve country.

**Resolution No. 4**

The Delegates of the countries of the Arc

*noting* the proposal made by the St. Petersburg Society for Surveying and Mapping to mark in 2007 the 150th anniversary of the publication of “Arc du

méridien de 25° 20' entre le Danube et la Mer Glaciale...”,

*welcome* the idea of a memorial booklet and agree to contribute the publication by submitting necessary geodetic and descriptive material by March 1, 2007.

### **Resolution No. 5**

The Delegates of the countries of the Arc

*considering* the historical importance of the arc measurement made on Spitsbergen,

*decides* to form a study group to prepare a documentation on the remains from the measurement as a probable extension of the present World Heritage. The group would have members from Sweden, Russia and Norway.

### **Resolution No. 6**

The Delegates of the countries of the Arc

*welcome* the proposal of the Delegation of Lithuania host the next Coordinating Committee Meeting in Lithuania in the year 2008; tentatively within the shift of August-September.

### **Resolution No. 7**

The Delegates of the countries of the Arc

*having* their Second Coordinating Committee Meeting in Haparanda, in August 14-15 August, 2006,
