

**RESOLUTIONS**  
**of the Third**  
**Coordinating Committee Meeting**  
**THE STRUVE GEODETIC ARC**  
**in Jēkabpils, Latvia, August 22 – 23, 2008**

The delegates of the countries of the Struve Geodetic Arc - Norway, Sweden, Finland, Russian Federation, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Belarus and Republic of Moldova - present in the Conference *Struve Geodetic Arc and Its Extension in Time and Space* adopted the following resolutions. (Ukraine was the only country not represented).

**Resolution No. 1**

The Delegates of countries of the Arc

*noting* the *Management Mechanism* for the Struve Geodetic Arc, as agreed in the Moldova Conference in 2004,

*welcome* the national management reports of 2007-2008 presented in this meeting,

*look forward* to continue the management cooperation of the Arc countries for the benefit and success of the Struve Arc as the World Heritage Monument.

**Resolution No. 2**

The Delegates of countries of the Arc

*noting* the activities of MSc Nienke Beintema and PhD Albert Beintema to make the Struve Arc known within a larger audience by articles, books and speeches,

*express* heartfelt thanks for their valuable contribution.

### **Resolution No. 3**

The Delegates of the countries of the Arc

*noting* the Diploma Thesis of Dipl.-Eng. Janine Peterhans - *International Forum for the Struve Geodetic Arc* -made in ETH Zürich / Technical University Zürich, and within the thesis the Wikipedia platform developed for common use of the ten Struve countries,

*express* heartfelt thanks for her valuable contribution,

*encourage* all the Struve Arc countries to take the platform and use it in order to unify and widen the publicity of the Arc.

### **Resolution No. 4**

The Delegates of the countries of the Arc

*noting* the need for an English translation of F.G.W. Struve's two volumes of "Report on the Arc of Meridian from the Danube to the Arctic Sea",

*recognizing* that the translation has now been completed and seen by most delegates of the countries concerned and that Norway and Sweden have already sponsored the work,

*encourage* the other countries to cosponsor the production of the printed version.

### **Resolution No. 5**

The Delegates of the countries of the Arc

*considering* the historical importance to preserve instruments used on the arc measurement,

*encourage* the countries to look for and identify the original instruments used by the Struve and Tenner teams as well as by Swedish and Norwegian teams and to preserve them to the future.

### **Resolution No. 6**

*welcome* the proposal of the Delegation of Lithuania to host the next Coordinating Committee Meeting in Lithuania in the year 2010.

### **Resolution No. 7**

The Delegates of the countries of the Arc

*noting* that the Coordinating Committee's Finnish chairmanship period is ending within this meeting,

*elect* unanimously Dr. Saulius Urbanas from the National Land Service of Lithuania as the Chairman of the Coordinating Committee.

*recognising* the efforts of Director General Jarmo Ratia and Chief-Engineer Pekka Tatila from the National Land Survey of Finland as Chairman and Secretary of the Coordinating Committee in 2004-2008,
